- [1] The Grand Draw ticket sales totalled £1,309 (2015-16:£1,096) and raised £1,109 net [2015-16:£821] including ticket sponsorship of £76
- [2] Subscriptions to the 200 Club in its financial year to 31 October 2016 raised a total of £2,000 (2014-15:£2,077) which provided monthly draw prizes totalling £1,040 (2014-15:£1,045) and a net surplus to Reading Room funds of £960 (2014-15:£1,032).

 In the financial year to 31 January 2017 the 200 Club provided £980 net (2015-16 £1,052) to Reading Room funds.
- [3] The Sustainable Fund receipt of £400 was a <u>Restricted Fund Grant</u> from South Hams District Council for the cost of building the new porch canopy There were no other Restricted Fund receipts in the year
- [4] Although New Purchases are shown as Nil, the Parish Council donated the purchase of a baby changing table
