## CHURCH NEWS

Our church is open daily for silent prayer, or to visitors who wish to see inside our lovely place of worship. Regular services of Morning Prayer are held each Sunday at 9:30 am except the third Sunday of each month when a service of Holy Communion takes place at 11:00 am. When there is a 5<sup>th</sup> Sunday in any month, there may be team services. Very occasionally there may be an extra Holy Communion service inserted instead of Morning Prayer and such a change will be noted in the church calendar at the back of the newsletters and at the end of the Church News column. There will be no services on Christmas Eve in our church. However there will be a service of Holy Communion at 9:30 am in St. Andrew's Church, Aveton Gifford. At 3:30 pm on Christmas Eve, in St. George's Church there will be two services – Family Nativity at 3:30 pm and Holy Communion at 11:00 pm. Here in Kingston, we will celebrate Holy Communion at 9:30 am on Christmas Day with Revd. Simon Farmer officiating.

**On 11<sup>th</sup> November, Remembrance Day**, we met at the War Memorial for the wreath laying ceremony and the Roll of Honour was read as we remembered all those from the village who had given their lives in past wars. On **Sunday, 13<sup>th</sup> November**, a **Remembrance Sunday** team service was held in Ringmore church.

**Christmas Carol Service**, led by the Revd. Matt Rowland, will be held in the Church on Wednesday, **21<sup>st</sup> December**. At the conclusion of the carol service, we will be serving sausage rolls, mince pies and mulled wine. We look forward to having you sing with us – hopefully in our choir, or if not, then please join others in the pews with family and friends.

There will be two additional Benefice carol services held this year if you are unable to join us in Kingston. The first is on **Sunday, 18<sup>th</sup> December at St George's, Modbury at 7:00 pm** and the second, at **All Hallows, Ringmore, on Thursday, 22<sup>nd</sup> December at 5:00 pm**. An area pop-up choir will be leading the congregation for these services and the carols and readings will be the same for both services.

**Please consider becoming a Friend of St James the Less church.** By becoming a Friend, you can be assured that our church and graveyard will still be here for the generations who follow us. You do not have to be a worshipper in our church in order to become a Friend. All are welcome. ### **Next Kingston Parish Council Meetings – Thursday 19<sup>th</sup> January 2023 in the Reading Room.**

The next Parish Council meeting will take place in the Reading Room at 7.30 pm on Thursday 19<sup>th</sup> January. The Agenda will be placed on the Parish Website ([www.kingstonparishcouncil.co.uk](http://www.kingstonparishcouncil.co.uk)) and the Parish Noticeboard (situated on the Fire Station wall) by Thursday 12<sup>th</sup> January. Public are welcome to join the Open Forum which is held at the beginning of each KPC meeting for any questions you may have.

### **Refuse and Recycling**

**Brown Bin Collections.** The free brown bin collection service has now ceased. Each household should have received a letter with the details of the opt-in, paying service (£49 per year per bin for a maximum of 2 bins per household) which is planned to start in March. You have until 22<sup>nd</sup> January 2023 to subscribe to the service, either via their website [www.southhams.gov.uk/gardenwaste](http://www.southhams.gov.uk/gardenwaste) or by calling 01803 861234. If you choose not to subscribe to the service you can either keep your brown bin and re-use it as garden storage or you can arrange to have it removed via [www.southhams.gov.uk/recyclingwaste](http://www.southhams.gov.uk/recyclingwaste) and selecting “contact the waste team”. If you do not subscribe to the service before 22<sup>nd</sup> January, you can still do so later but your first collection will happen at a later date.

**Christmas Tree Collection.** There will be no Christmas Tree collection service this year.

**Recycling Service.** Performance across the South Hams is now improving since South Hams District Council (SHDC) brought the service back in-house in October, but there is still a long way to go. SHDC still aspire to introduce the full recycling service planned as part of the original changes FCC struggled to introduce from 2020, but this will take several months at least and changes (e.g. reintroduction of food waste collection) are not likely until well into 2023.

**Modbury Church Street Closure.** Sections of Modbury Church Street will be closed for approximately 3 months from 19<sup>th</sup> January to allow essential water works and repairs to take place. A dedicated website with details of which sections are closed when will go live in due course – details will be provided in the January newsletter.

### **Free Holiday Activities with Hot Meals for Young Children.**

A government-funded programme of activities and hot meals for the Christmas 2022 school holiday has just been published. All sessions will be a minimum of 4 hours and the programme includes a wide range of activities, such as cooking and craft, sports and coaching, outdoor and forest play, music and dance, and much more. Parents and carers can book places with providers now, via:

<https://www.devon.gov.uk/educationandfamilies/document/haf-providers-christmas-2022/#introduction>. All children are eligible, although priority places will be given to children aged 5-16 who are eligible for and receiving benefit-related free school meals and their families.

**Winter Preparedness.** If needed, there are grit supplies in bins at certain points around the village. However, please remember that grit is supposed for use *on the village highways only*. In the event of very cold weather, Cllr Merv Freeman will bring out the parish supplies of salt. If you need to use this salt, the ratio is *ONLY 1 tablespoon per square metre*.

### Kingston Reading Room

#### Hall Hire charges 2023



- Sessions are 8:30am to 1:30pm, 1:30pm to 6:30pm, 6:30pm to 11:30pm. If more time is needed to set up or clear away, then it must be booked.
- Commercial events are charged at £7.50 per hour or part hour, including set up and clean up times.
- The charge for sole occupancy of the Reading Room for a full day is by negotiation.
- Hall uses that satisfy the objects of the Reading Room charity trust deed are charged at a subsidised £10 per session. They must be non-profit (and may be subject to financial review) and open to all residents of Kingston Parish, be advertised in the Kingston Newsletter and on Kingston related social media (e.g. KEG Facebook page) as such and be approved by the Management Committee at least one month in advance of the first session.
- Private parties for Kingston Parish residents are charged at a concessionary rate of £10 per session.
- The downstairs meeting room is charged at £5 per session.
- Bookings are recorded in the Reading Room bookings calendar which is available on the Parish Council website. Please check the calendar before requesting a booking.

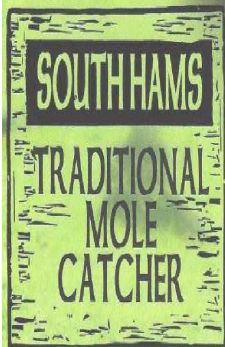
