The following notes apply to all classes.

Entry is free in all classes but we ask for a donation to cover the cost of running the show.

Entries should be a submitted on the form that will be published in the Kingston Newsletter, copies of which can be requested from the email

Entries should be submitted prior to the 25th July by email or posted to Dolphin Lodge (opposite Yellands Park)

Entries, other than for Class J, should be staged in the Reading Room before 11.00am on Saturday 27th July after which the judging will be conducted.

Entries for each class should only be identified by an Entrant number provided by the organiser at staging.



Notes:

Class J Open Art

- Entries may be in any medium.
- All entries should be unsigned and must have the following information on the back name and category.
- All entries should be mounted and can be of any size.
- However, if they are larger than A₃ you must provide a means of support (eg an easel).
- There is a limit of 3 entries per person in any one category and 4 entries overall.
- Any works previously exhibited in the show are not eligible.
- The aggregate points winner will be awarded Best-in-Show.
- The Anne Scarratt Cup will be awarded for what is judged to be the best individual exhibit from the 4 category winners.

Entries should be submitted either to the Art Club on the Wednesday before the show or to the church by 10am on the morning of the show.

Other Classes

- The entry form will be made available for manual or electronic submission.
- There will not be an entry fee **but** we would request a donation to cover the cost of hiring the RR and other necessary expenditure. Any surplus to be retained for the running of subsequent shows. All costs will be published.
- The entrant will be provided with an entry number
- Entries shall be staged on plain paper plates, or with plain label, showing the entrant number and class and should otherwise be anonymous to viewers (and judges)
- There is no limit to the number of classes entered but will be limited to one entry per subclass. e.g. 1 x chutney
- The top 3 entrants in each sub-class will be awarded points and the Class winner will be the entrant that secures the most points overall in the class. The basis for the allocation of points will be published on the Entry Form.
- A list of trophies for the classes will be published later.

The judges decision is final.
